What is N.E.T?

Non-Emergency Transportation is a statewide program administered by Wayne County Department of Job and Family Services. This program can provide transportation assistance to eligible individuals going to and from Medicaid approved, non-emergency medical appointments by providing gas vouchers issued to one of seven contracted gas stations throughout Wayne County.

How can I participate in the program?

To participate you must be a current Medicaid recipient. You will need to fill out an application and complete a face to face interview with the Transportation Coordinator to determine eligibility.

What information will I need to provide?

During the initial application process you will need to provide a valid driver's license and a copy of your current car insurance card. While participating in this program, you will be required to keep this documentation up to date and on file with us to receive gas vouchers.
